

## How to get an ISIC

Simply complete the application form below and either post it or take it to your nearest ISIC Issuing Office. You will also need to provide:

- **Proof of your full-time student status**  
Your local student registration card or a letter on official stationery from your secondary school, college or university stating that you are a full-time student for the current academic year.
- **1 Passport size photo**
- **Fee** US\$10 or T/shs equivalent. Bring exact change.  
There is a fee for the ISIC. Contact your local ISIC Issuing Office to inquire about the correct amount.
